On behalf of the Awake ICPF 2025 leadership team, I would like to extend my sincere thanks and appreciation to everyone who came, supported and prayed for a blessed camp this past March. We had over 800 students attend camp this year with sessions focused on middle school, high school, college and young adults. Our elementary students were led into deep interactive sessions from local volunteers as well as Christ for the Nations kids ministry.

I remember in 2001 coming to ICPF camp for the very first time. It was focused on mainly college students and there were only about 50 people in attendance. I used to sit in the balcony and watch as people would worship and receive Christ for the first time. It inspired me to want to be a part of a movement where I could encounter the Lord on a deeper and more personal level. I spent years in children's ministry until I was of age to attend the sessions in high school, college and ext. Who I am today and my deep admiration of Christ and radical encounters of the Holy Spirit have been due to ICPF camp. I believe camps like these are needed for our community to have an outlet to connect with other students, have spirit led worship sessions, messages that are applicable for the season of their life and small groups to build accountability and perspective. I believe your local church should be pouring into you on a weekly basis, its important to equip the youth with everyday Biblical teaching to face the real world and a shifting cultural presence. These camps and conferences that are put on in our Malayalee community are meant to connect and bring our community together. We want to address certain topics that are not being discussed at home and local churches, have a safe space to be vulnerable and open up about personal struggles and build a deeper sense of belonging to the purpose and mission Christ has called us to live in.

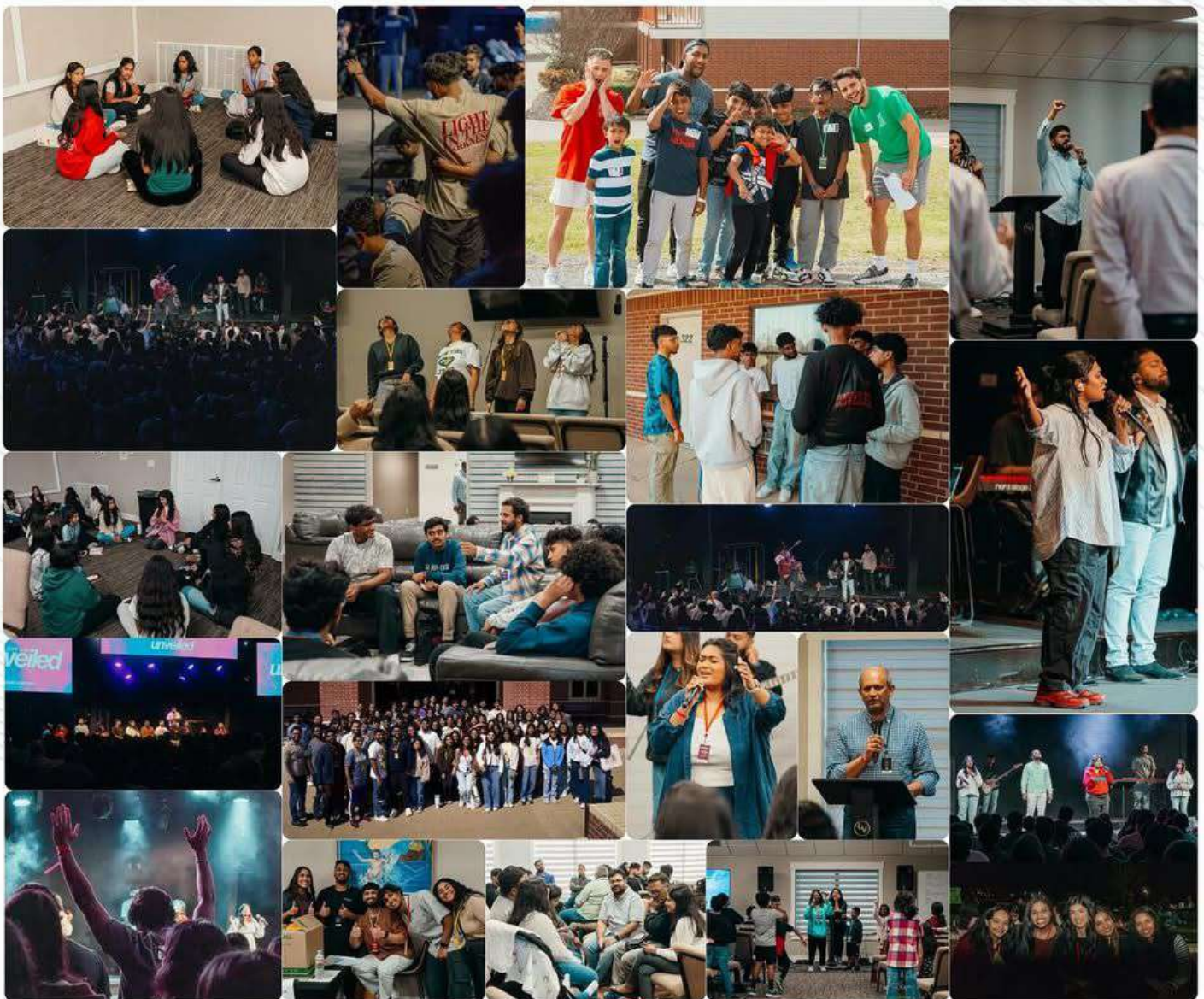
